Mammalian, Avian & Reptilian Diet Review

The Cikananga Rescue Center takes care of on average 360 wild animals that are confiscated, rescued or evacuated from the wildlife trade or conflict situations. With 80 species of animals of different taxa a continuous developing knowledge on nutrition and diet requirements we have internship openings focused on meeting the dietary requirements for all animals.

At the moment we are looking for interns to review the diets of the leaf-monkeys, hornbills, turtles, gibbons and siamangs, and ground cuscus. In undertaking a review of each species diet, interns will review the current diets offered to the animals at CWC, review current nutritional research and data, and suggest alterations to the species diet taking into account local availability of food items. Important is that where to include in this review the way food is presented to the animals, and cost-effective alterations to improve both animal welfare and cost effectiveness. After approval by caretakers, animal welfare manager and financial manager, trails can be undertaken. All activities will be done with supervision of Cikananga staff who are Bahasa Indonesia and/ or English and / or Dutch speaking.
